

Extraordinary Council Meeting of Friday 23 of April 2010.

An extraordinary Council Meeting was held last Friday. Lately, all meetings tend to end with endless quarrelling. Electoral fever might be the reason, as the next municipal elections are only 1 year away.

We didn't report on the last ordinary meeting because there was a complete lack of consideration, with foolish accusations and little of general interest for our village. Only one point was of interest and referred to a grant that would in part pay for covering the "polideportivo" or sports centre. The grant came to 750.000€, but another 700.000€ were necessary to complete the work, "money that we don't have" according the Mayor. Finally, the Mayor decided to consult the people of Alcaucín.

- In the Council Meeting last Friday, the Major revealed the result of the consultation: 67% against and only 23% in favor. PSOE insists that we lose 750.000€ while the Mayor insists that we save over 700.000€.
- Chiropody service: the free chiropody service is now modified. The patient will have to contribute 5€ per session. This measure was necessary to resolve the endless queues. The only requirement: being registered in Alcaucín and the payment of 5€ for the session of about 20 minutes. Consult the Town Hall for more information.
- The "Teacher's House", near the little church in Venta Baja will be demolished. A new multi-purpose centre will be build with a "lower floor" of approximately 70M² and the "upper floor" of about 170M².
- A few other points were discussed, all of them of no interest for the purpose of this article.
