

MEETING POINT: Restaurante La Parra in Alcaucín Road.
DATE: SATURDAY, 16th April 2011
TIME: 10:00 am
APPROX. DURATION: 3 Hours
APPROX. DISTANCE: 6 Kms.

We start our walk in Restaurante La Parra and go up to the road of Alcaucín to Las Huertas. After going through this hamlet we will arrive at what is called "El Santo" (the saint) and we'll take the track going up on our right.

This part of the walk can be considered difficult as we go up a hill, (300 m). Going up we will have as a reference a black and white sign (coto de caza).

Once on the top we follow the path direction East. This way we go round the hill always with Sierra Tejeda on our right.

In the next 45 minutes, we stay on this path easy which is easy to recognize by the many bullet shells left by the local and disrespectful hunters.

At the end of this path we find a track, and if we look down to the right we can see the hamlet of Las Majadas. We follow the track and soon join the road that comes from the hamlet of "El Espino".

When we get to Las Majadas, we cross through one of its streets to reach the access to "Los Baños", a clear path between two fences.

We go down and we find a few small springs. These are "Los Baños de Las Majadas" and the end of this walk.

We walk up back to the town to have our lunch in one of the streets surrounded by lemons and oranges trees. After our rest we will go back the same way.

When we return to Restaurante La Parra if you wish, you could stay and try one of its delicious tapas, have a drink and talk about our walk.
