

## ALCAUCÍN- NACIMIENTO DEL RIO BERMUZA-ALCAUCÍN

MEETING POINT: Plaza de la Fuente de Los Cinco Caños, en C/ La Fuente. Alcaucín  
DATE: SATURDAY 23rd April 2011  
TIME: 10:00 am  
DISTANCE: 9 Kms  
TIME: 4 Hours

This walk will take us to the Rio Bermuza source, in the municipality of Canillas de Aceituno.

We will walk through Alcaucín town going up to the Graveyard. We carry on in what is now a proper road, to La Loma de Canillas. Once there, we will take a track that goes up on our left, and pass by the relay masts until we reach an electricity pylon on the left at the end of the track. Here we take a path that goes around Sierra Tejada Natural Park. After 30 minutes on this path we arrive at a gate and start going down through pine woods until we find a little square.

We cross another gate and then we take the path left from square, going round again the Natural Park. We stay on this path for another hour approximately, until we see on the left, "La Cueva de la Fájara" (Fájara cave).

At this point we start going down to the river bed, which we follow going south. We are now in The Source of the Rio Bermuza.

Once there, we go through another gate and follow a pipe, also going south. In 10 minutes, passing through an olive and fruit tree grove, we go down to "El Molino de Enmedio", an abandoned mill.

Here we can have our lunch and get our strength back to go back the same way.
